



DRESS CODE



Members & Visitors are asked to follow the Dress Code applied by the Club and also to advise their guests playing the course or attending the Clubhouse of the Dress Code. The Club wishes to preserve a smart but casual approach based on clothing that is principally designed for golf. As however, dress sense is a highly subjective topic, the Club would appreciate your support in maintaining the following standard of dress which will apply to all persons 18 years of age and over;

ON THE COURSE

PROPER GOLFING ATTIRE IS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES

ACCEPTABLE

Smart casual wear, Tailored shorts only, tailored shirts, golf shoes

UNACCEPTABLE

Vests or other sleeveless shirts, shell-suits, tracksuits, football shirts, shirts without collars(except recognised golf attire), denims, sport or beach shorts, caps to be worn the right way round, trousers must not be tucked into socks(unless under waterproof clothing) begrimed work clothing, ripped or torn clothing, trainers.

NB Caddies will also be expected to abide by these rules but shall be allowed to wear trainers.

BAR/LOUNGE/DINING AREA

UNACCEPTABLE

As above

Vests (Except Ladies evening wear)

Any type of headwear

Any type of shoe worn to play golf.

THESE REGULATIONS APPLY TO BOTH MEMBERS & VISITORS ALIKE AND DISREGARD FOR THESE VERY REASONABLE STANDARDS CAN LEAD TO THE PERSON OR PERSONS CONCERNED BEING ASKED TO LEAVE THE COURSE OR THE CLUBHOUSE. WHILST ALL STAFF & CLUB OFFICIALS (PAST & PRESENT) ARE AUTHORISED TO APPROACH ANYONE IF THE DRESS CODE IS NOT BEING ADHERED TO, WE WOULD ALSO ENCOURAGE ALL MEMBERS TO BE PROACTIVE WHERE PERSONS ARE INAPPROPRIATELY DRESSED. PLEASE AVOID EMBARRASSING SITUATIONS, AS NO MEMBER OF STAFF IS PERMITTED TO ALLOW ANY EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE. ANYONE BEING UNCOOPERATIVE OR ABUSIVE TO STAFF WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE AND THE MATTER REPORTED TO THE COMMITTEE.
