

LOCAL RULES

- 1. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE** - All roads and paths are integral parts of the course. A ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable (Rule 28).
- 2. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25-1)** -
 - a) Areas marked as Ground Under Repair will be defined by blue stakes or enclosed by blue lines.
 - b) Plantations of young trees - If a player's ball lies in such an area or it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under rule 25-1.
 - c) Young trees - If staked trees, yellow banded or trees under one club length in height, interfere with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted and dropped in accordance with the procedure described in Rule 24-2b (Immovable Obstructions)
- 3. EMBEDDED BALL** - A ball embedded in its own pitch mark within a closely mown area may be lifted and dropped under Rule 25-2.
- 4. OUT OF BOUNDS** - A ball landing over the boundary fence separating the two halves of the course will be deemed out of bounds. The ground and the burn to the right of the 6th hole are out of bounds. The practice area to the right of the 17th and area to the right of the 14th fairway are out of bounds. All players are responsible for any damage caused to neighbouring property and should report same in incident book in Clubhouse.
- 5. STONES IN BUNKERS** - Stones in Bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.
- 6. OVERHEAD POWER LINES** - If a ball strikes an overhead power line the player **must** disregard that stroke, abandon the ball and play another ball as near as possible to the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance with Rule 20-5.
- 7. DRAINAGE TRACKS** - Drainage tracks are to be treated as ground under repair allowing a free lift and drop, not nearer the hole, at the nearest spot giving relief.
- 8. AERATION HOLES** - A ball coming to rest on an aeration hole on the putting green may be placed at the nearest spot, not nearer the hole, which avoids the situation.
- 9. DISTANCE MARKERS** - Distance Markers and their immediate coloured surrounds on the fairways are to be treated as immovable obstructions, allowing a free lift and drop not nearer the hole when the ball or players stance is affected.
- 10. LATERAL WATER HAZARD** - A ball coming to rest in the lateral water hazard to the left and rear of the 9th green when playing the 9th hole, may be played from the dropping zones adjacent to the 9th hole, under the penalty defined in Rule 26.
- 11. SPRINKLER HEADS** - Relief from interference can be obtained under Rule 24-2 and if ball lies off putting green but not in a hazard and is on or within two club-lengths of sprinkler on line of play between ball and hole relief may be taken as follows:
The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where ball lay that a) is not nearer the hole b) avoids intervention and c) is not in a hazard or on putting green. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.
- 12. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES** - For all play at this course, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

**Blue: 200 yards / 183 metres
Yellow: 150 yards / 137 metres
Red: 100 yards / 91 metres**
